Begin your Ag-venture at the Northern Crops Institute on the campus of North Dakota State University. NCI is a learning center that focuses on supporting regional agriculture by providing education and technical programs for crops that grow in the northern region of the United States.

While on campus, you must visit the NDSU Greenhouse which provides a modern state-of-the-art facility to advance current research capabilities. The 153,000 square-foot facility is about 300 yards long, with 100 separate chambers that provide different environments for a variety of plants. Later, take a tour of the Case IH Manufacturing site and see how the famous red farm equipment comes to life.

Ever wondered what goes on in an Anheuser-Busch Plant? Now is your chance to find out! Enjoy a sneak peek into the inner workings of the Moorhead malt plant.
